REPORT

Stewards on the 19th of December, 2014, conducted an Inquiry into comments posted by Cassie Saunders on the Social Media site "Facebook" on the 25th of November, 2014. Stewards received evidence concerning these posts from a third party on 16th of December 2014.

After reviewing the evidence, on the 21st of January 2015, stewards have sent Cassie Saunders a request to provide both evidence and reason as to why she should not be charged with a breach of rule 86(q), in that she did post comments on the Social media site "Facebook" which in the opinion of Stewards was detrimental to the interest, image and promotion of Arabian Racing.

Stewards have given Cassie Saunders seven (7) days to respond to these allegations.

UPDATE - 6th FEBRUARY. 2015.

A letter of was received from Cassie Saunders regarding the comments posted on the social media site, Facebook. This was received on, 28th January, 2015.

This was discussed by the stewards panel and a decision was made that due to the information provided in the letter, a caution would be noted against Cassie Saunders and that any further breaches of this rule/s may lead to more severe disciplinary action.
